Name of National Law	Entwurf eines Gesetzes zur Umsetzung der NIS-2-Richtlinie und zur Regelung wesentlicher Grundzüge des Informationssicherheitsmanagements in der Bundesverwaltung (abbr. NIS-2-Implementation Act)
Entered into force	Industry experts expect the law to enter into force by end of 2025.

<b>Scope</b> (deviating from NIS-2-Directive)	(Additional) categories of entities in scope: Critical infrastructure, very important entities, important entities (exemptions for small entities pursuant to NIS-2).
Registration	The registration rules go beyond the requirements of the Directive and oblige additional entities defined in the implementing law to register on the joint registration platform of Federal Information Security Office (Bundesamt für Sicherheit in der Informationstechnik (BSI)) and Federal Office of Civil Protection and Disaster Assistance (Bundesamt für Bevölkerungsschutz und Katastrophenhilfe (BKK)) within 3 months of being a regulated entity.
Information Security Standards referenced	N/A (ISO/IEC 27001 only for Federal Administration)
Incident reporting	Reports must be made to a joint point of contact of the Federal Information Security Office and the Federal Office of Civil Protection and Disaster Assistance.
Authority / CSIRT	Federal Information Security Office (BSI) and Federal Office of Civil Protection and Disaster Assistance (BKK)
Fines (deviating from NIS-2-Directive)	<ul> <li>Violation of enforceable orders issued by the competent authority, depending on the specific regulations violated: From up to EUR 100.000 to EUR 10.000.000 (partially reference to the Administrative Offenses Act (OWiG))</li> </ul>
Worth mentioning	Complex interplay between sector-specific cyber regulation and NIS-2 Implementation Laws.
