Name of National Law	Emergency Ordinance no. 155/2024 on the establishment of a framework for the cybersecurity of networks and information systems in the national civil cyberspace

Scope (deviating from NIS-2-Directive)	Additional entities are under the scope of E.O. no. 155/2024, compared to NIS-2, such as offshore wind turbine operators, aircraft maintenance operators, civil aviation agents, as defined by the local legislation.
Registration	Currently, there is only a draft order from the National Cyber Security Directorate (DNSC), which provides that registration will be carried out through an online platform made available by the authority.
Information Security Standards referenced	N/A
Incident reporting	Essential and important entities must report significant security incidents to DNSC.
Authority / CSIRT	The Romanian National Cyber Security Directorate/in Romanian Directoratul Național de Securitate Cibernetică DNSC
Fines (deviating from NIS-2-Directive)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The minimum fine for important entities is RON 5.000 (~EUR 1.000), and for essential entities, it is RON 10.000 (~EUR 2.000).
Worth mentioning	Essential entities and important entities appoint the persons responsible for the security of networks and information systems, broader scope of obligated entities, management is required to follow accredited training.
